Rectifier with an Input Line Fault Indicator

Description

- A circuit which rectifies an ac line voltage and provides an indicator signal to a controller of a power converter to indicate a fault condition in the ac line voltage V_{AC}
- Indicates a fault if the ac line voltage V_{AC} has been removed from the input of the power converter or fallen below a threshold value

Benefits

- Works with two line and three line systems
- Very low power consumption
- Low cost
- Could be used with: LNKZero-AX




Figure 1. Example circuit which rectifies and provides an indicator signal
